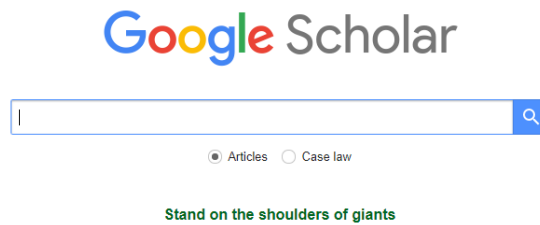


How to Sign Up for Google Scholar

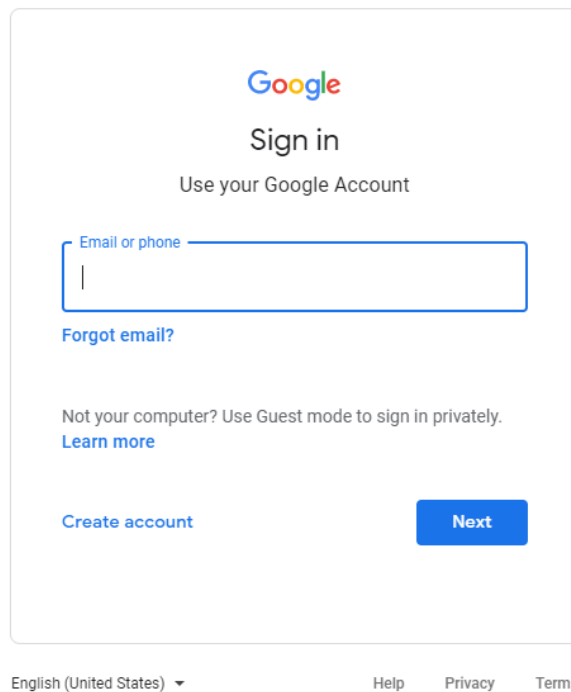
1. Go to scholar.google.com
2. Click the 'Sign In' link in the upper right corner:
